Overview

The Secondary 2 students will be involved in a 4Day 3 Night Outdoor Adventure Camp, which will be held at the Dairy Farm MOE Adventure Centre. This camp will provide a challenging and 'outside of the comfort zone' learning environment for the students to build a sense of resilience and resourcefulness.
