

Collection Procedures

- contains the gross aggregate scores for JC, MI, polytechnic and ITE aggregate types.
- the courses that you are eligible to apply in the JAE.

Collection Procedures

- You need to ***sign*** on the class list to acknowledge receipt of documents.
- You have to check that your name is **printed correctly** on your certificate and result slip.

Direct School Admission: JC / Early Admission Exercise (EAE)

- All students **successfully** admitted to a school through DSA-JC / EAE will not be able to participate in JAE.
- Your **Form A** will show that you have been admitted to an institution through DSA-JC / EAE.

- If posted to a **JC or MI course**, report to the posted institution on **4 Feb 2026**.
- Students who have **accepted** offers under the DSA-JC, Poly EAE or ITE EAE will be informed of the **outcome** via the registered email addresses from **2.45pm** on **14 Jan 2026**.

Submit an Appeal:

You can submit an appeal only after the release of the JAE posting results.

If you want to submit an appeal for:

Polytechnics and Institute of Technical Education (ITE)

- Submit your appeal from **9am on Tuesday, 3 February 2026 to 4pm on Friday, 6 February 2026** through the [JAE Online Appeal Portal](#).

After you submitted your appeal:

- While you wait for the outcome, you should still report to the institution you are posted to. If your appeal is successful, inform your institution subsequently.

- Refer to the school websites to find out when and how the appeal outcome will be released.





- If you are **inactive** on JAE-IS for more than **15 minutes**, you will be logged out automatically. Any information that you have entered **will not be saved**.
- You must provide a **local mobile phone number** during registration if you wish to receive the results of application through SMS.

- **PFP-eligible** students will receive a copy of **Form P** which contains a unique password.

- Applications for the **PFP** will open from **1.30pm on 14 January 2026**, to **4.30pm on 19 January 2026**.
- The **PFP *posting results*** will be released at **1.30pm on 26 January 2026** through the **PFP website**.
- Students will be **required** to indicate whether they wish to ***accept*, *reject*, or *appeal*** for a change of course by **4.30pm on 29 January 2026**.

- Eligible Secondary 4 N(A) students may submit their **DPP** applications online via the DPP application portal at www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses
- Applications for the **DPP** will open from **12am on 14 January 2026 to 11.59pm on 19 January 2026**.
- The **DPP** **posting results** for applications made under the final application phase will be released at **9am on 21 January 2026** through the **DPP application portal**.
- Students will be **required** to indicate whether they **accept** or **reject** the DPP offer by **11.59pm on 26 January 2026**.

For **successful** DPP and/or PFP applicants

- Students who have been offered a place in the **DPP** under the final application phase should **report to ITE on 26 January 2026** upon **acceptance** of their DPP course offer.
- The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the **PFP** will be on **30 January 2026**. Students will be informed by the **respective polytechnics** on the enrolment dates for the PFP.
- Students who have accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but decide to take up a PFP offer must **withdraw** from the DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer. DPP-enrolled students should check with their **ITE class advisor** for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal.
